

## **Oracle Workforce Development Programme (WDP) through CHIPS for Graduate/Postgraduate students**

Chhattisgarh infotech and biotech Promotion Society (CHIPS) is the nodal agency of Government of Chhattisgarh and prime mover for propelling IT growth and implementation of IT/e-Governance in the state. CHIPS also aims at providing entrepreneurship training and education in IT to the students of the state and generating opportunities for self-employment, creating competent rural entrepreneurs through subsidized training courses and initiating the spirit of 'Entrepreneurship' among youth.

Accordingly, a centre for providing specialised training in various fields of IT to the students of the state has been set up at Raipur. To begin with tie-up has been done with ORACLE for providing the Oracle Workforce Development Programme (WDP) to the Engineering Graduate/Postgraduate/MCA/BCA/M.Sc/B.Sc(IT/CS) students of the state. The following courses are now being provided at this centre:

- Oracle Database 10g: Introduction to SQL 3.0
- Oracle Database 10g: Administration Workshop I 3.1
- Fundamentals of Java Programming Language, Java SE 6, 1.1
- Java Programming Language, Java SE 6, 1.1

Duration of each course is 40 hours (2 hours a day). Each Student needs to undergo at least two modules (80 hours) to complete a track. The students have to bring their own laptop. These programs will expose the students to Oracle University official curriculum, E-course ware and Line & Live Training Methodology. This will also help the students to get awarded with the Global Participation Certificates which are clear differentiators from their peers, when looking for jobs. Students passing this programme would also get discount vouchers from Oracle for attending further advanced certification courses.

Students need to download application form available on website and submit it to CHIPS Office, Raipur. Before the commencement of subsequent batch, the students would be contacted and they have to submit D.D before the commencement of course. Next batch starts from 1<sup>st</sup> week of June, 2014.
